

**Philanthropy in the Washington Region: A Snapshot of 2007**

In 2007, foundations in the Washington region gave more than \$789 million, a 6% increase since our last analysis (2005). Over that period, the value of total assets for foundations in the region increased by 15%, from \$11.5 billion to \$13.2 billion.

Contributions by the top twenty corporate donors totaled nearly \$140 million. The two top corporate givers were mortgage giants Freddie Mac and Fannie Mae, which gave a combined \$46.67 million.
